The tool helps members of the kindergarten through grade 12 (K-12) school community more easily find, apply for, and ultimately receive school safety-related funding. It houses Federally available school safety-related grants in one centralized location, as well as provides school personnel with a variety of ways to search for and access grant opportunities from across the Federal government. K-12 schools and districts can use the tool to find funding opportunities to enhance, promote, and advance school safety measures and initiatives.

The tool provides several, easy-to-use features to assist members of the K-12 community in finding grants and funding opportunities for their school or district. Through the tool, schools and districts can:

- Take a comprehensive quiz to determine their eligibility and applicability for grants that match their specific school needs.
- · Search through pre-populated lists organized around relevant grant topics.
- Filter grants by specific criteria such as school safety topic, award amount, application level of effort, and more.
